Tree Pick-up will be April 13, 2019, 9:00am-1:00pm at the Livingston Road Commission Garage 3535 Grand Oaks Dr., Howell (2-2 indicates the trees have spent two years in a seed bed and two years in a transplant bed. Likewise, 3-0 indicates three years in a seed bed and zero years in a transplant bed. Transplants have a larger root system than regular seedlings. The Livingston Conservation District distributes only the best nursery stock at an affordable price.)
